NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Himachal Pradesh, in consultation with the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission is pleased to make the Recruitment and Promotion Rules for the post of Junior Tailoring Mistress (Class-III, Non-Gazetted) in the Department of Technical Education, Vocational and Industrial Training Himachal Pradesh as per Annexure "A" attached to this notification, namely:-

Short title and Commencement:

1. (i) These Rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh, Technical Education, Vocational & Industrial Training Department (Class-III, Non-Gazetted) Recruitment and Promotion Rules, 1987 for the post of Junior Tailoring Mistress.

- (ii) These shall come into force from the date of publication in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh.

2. Rules:

The number of posts, classification, pay scale qualifications and method of Recruitment etc. for the Post of Junior Tailoring Mistress (Class-III, Non-Gazetted) shall be as specified in the Annexure "A".

3. Repeal and Saving:

The Recruitment and Promotion Rules which were applicable for the post of Junior Tailoring Mistress in the Deptt. of Technical Education, Vocational and Industrial Training,

ANNEXURE-I

Recruitment and Promotion Rules for the post of Junior Tailoring Mistress in the Department of Technical Education in the H.P. Government.

1. Name of the Post: Junior Tailoring Mistress.
2. Number of Posts: 31 (Thirty One).
3. Classification: Class-III (Non-Gazetted).
4. Scale of Pay: Rs. 510-15-600/20-700/25-850-30-940.
5. Whether selection or non-Selection Post: Non-Selection.
6. Age for direct Recruitment: Between 18 and 32 years.

Provided that the upper age limits for direct recruits will not be applicable to the candidates already in service of the Government including those who have been appointed on adhoc or on contract basis:

Provided further that if a candidate appointed on adhoc basis had become overage on the date when he was appointed as such he shall not be eligible for any relaxation in the prescribed age limit by virtue of his such adhoc or contract appointment;

Provided further that upper age limit is relaxable for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/other categories of persons to the extent permissible under the general or special orders of the Himachal Pradesh Government;

Provided further that the employees of all the public sector corporations and autonomous bodies who happened to be Government servants before absorption in the Public Sector Corporation/Autonomous Bodies at the time of initial constitution of such Corporation/Autonomous Bodies shall be allowed age concession in direct recruitment as admissible to Government servants. This concession will not, however, be admissible to such staff of the Public Sector Corporations/Autonomous Bodies who were are subsequently appointed by such Corporations/Autonomous Bodies and are/were finally absorbed in the service of such Corporations/Autonomous Bodies after initial constitution of the public sector Corporations/Autonomous Bodies.

Note:1.

Age limit for direct recruitment will be reckoned on the first day of the year in which the post(s) are advertised for inviting applications or notified to the Employment Exchanges, as the case may be.

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Note:2.

Age and experience in the case of direct recruitment are reliable at the discretion of the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission in case of the candidates otherwise well qualified.

7. Minimum educational and other qualifications required for direct recruitment:

ESSENTIAL

- i) Matric with Mathematics or its equivalent from a recognised University/Board.
- ii) Two years Diploma in Tailoring & Cutting and Embroidery & Needle Work.

OR

One year National Trade Certificate in Cutting & Tailoring and one year National Trade Certificate in Embroidery and Needle work.

Desirable Qualifications:

- i) At least 2 years experience in the trade concerned.
- ii) Knowledge of customs, manners and dialects of Himachal Pradesh and suitability for appointment in the peculiar conditions prevailing in the Pradesh.

8. Whether age and educational qualification prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of probationees:

9. Period of probation, if any:

Two years subject to such further extension for a period of not exceeding one year as may be ordered by the competent authority in special circumstances and reasons to be recorded in writing.

100% by direct recruitment.

12. If a Departmental Promotion Committee exists, what is its composition.

13. Circumstances under which the H.P.S.C. is to be consulted in making recruitment.

As required under the Law.

14. Essential requirement for a direct recruit:

A candidate for appointment to any service or post must be:-

- (a) A citizen of India, or
- (b) A subject of Nepal, or
- (c) A subject of Bhutan, or
- (d) A Tibetan refugee who crossed over to India before the 1st January, 1982 with the intention of permanently settling in India;
- (e) A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (Formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, and Ethiopia with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (b), (c), (d) and (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India.

A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission or other recruiting authority, but the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government of India.

15. Selection for appointment to post by direct recruitment:

Selection for appointment to the post in the case of direct recruitment shall be made on the basis of viva voce test; and if the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission or other recruiting authority, as the case may be, so consider necessary or expedient by a written test or a practical test, the standard/syllabus etc. of which, will be determined by the Commission/other recruiting authority as the case may be.

16. Reservation:

The appointment to this service shall be subject to orders regarding reservation in the services for Scheduled Casts/ Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes other categories of persons issued by the H.P. Government from time to time.

17. Power to Relax:

Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

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
