NOTIFICATION

In partial modification of this department's Notification of even number dated 21st January, 2015 and in exercise of powers conferred under Section 5 of the "Himachal Pradesh Private Technical and Vocational Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fee) Act, 2008" (Act No.16 of 2008), the Governor Himachal Pradesh is pleased to notify the following eligibility criteria for admission from academic session 2015-16 onwards in respect of the institutions as specified under Section 2 of the Act 2008 ibid i.e. the institutions deemed to be Universities, or Universities established under a State Act or constituent units thereto, other than those promoted and maintained by the Central Government; and imparting technical, vocational or professional education; and the private aided or unaided technical, vocational or professional educational institutions affiliated to a University, which has been established under section 2 (f) of the University Grant Commission Act, 1956 from the academic session 2015-16 onwards :
