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


the short term courses 100% funded by HPSDP have been started in 56 Nos. Govt. ITI. The MOUs with HPKVN have already been signed by the concerned Principals. The committee granted ex-post facto approval to the agenda item.

15.05 The Ex- post facto permission to sign the MOU between Directorate of Technical Education and HPKVN to start Short Term courses funded by HPSDP in ITIs.

The Member Secretary informed the committee that the Short Term NSQF aligned training under State Sector Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 3.0 have been started in 07 Nos. Govt. ITIs. The MOUs with HPKVN have already been signed between Directorate of Technical Education and HPKVN. The committee granted ex-post facto approval to the agenda item.

15.06 The Ex- post facto permission to pay revised rates of honorarium/ remuneration to the staff involved in implementation of Short Term Courses running in the ITI funded by HPSDP.

The Committee was informed that the rates of honorarium/ remuneration to the staff involved in implementation of Short Term Courses was approved in the 14th State Steering committee. Further, it was also informed that as per letter No. HPKVN-1(272)-2018-Vol-II-2834 dt. 15/01/2021 received from HPKVN, a Committee was constituted at Directorate level vide Office Order No. 121 dated 23/01/2021 for reconsideration of honorarium/ remuneration being

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paid to the staff engaged for the short term courses of HPSDP/ HPKVN. The amended/ revised rates duly approved by the Sub-Committee (as per Annexure-A) were circulated to the all Govt. ITIs vide Directorate letter No. STV(IT)HA(3)/2/NCVT/STSDC/2020- 69667-69799 dated 23/10/2021 and are being implemented. The representative of HPKVN present in the meeting also gave his consent on the matter. After detailed deliberation, the committee granted ex-post facto approval to the revised rates being paid to the staff involved in implementation of Short Term Courses running in the ITIs.

15.07 The Ex-post facto approval for constitution/re-constitution of IMCs for Govt. ITIs.

The Member Secretary informed the Committee that the IMCs for some of the Govt. ITIs have been constituted/re-constituted by the Govt. The committee extended its ex-post facto approval for the constitution/reconstitution of these ITIs. It was also apprised to the Committee that the internal Committees have been constituted at Directorate level, wherever the tenure of IMCs have been completed or the IMCs have been dissolved due to resigning of Chairman/ members. The committee also granted ex-post facto approval to the constitution/ re-constitution of these IMCs.

The Member Secretary informed the Committee that

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

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


